

Lamps Plus extends protection to 99% of systems while cutting costs with Veeam Vault

Lamps Plus is one of the largest specialty lighting retailers in the U.S, serving customers through its online store front and dozens of physical locations across the western states. Behind every order is a large IT estate with more than 300 virtual servers powering core applications and 1,200 endpoints across warehouses, call centers, headquarters, and retail branches. For a business where most sales come through e-commerce, any outage can quickly translate into lost revenue and reputational risk.

The company's existing data protection tools left it exposed. A legacy, agent-based solution covered only 30% of the corporate environment, leaving critical systems without consistent backup or recovery options. At the same time, ransomware was becoming a daily concern. The IT team set out to close these gaps by protecting the full environment, creating hardened, redundant copies of production data, and enabling recovery processes that could withstand the demands of a retail business running around the clock.

After evaluating the market, Lamps Plus chose Veeam Data Platform with Veeam Vault as the foundation for its new approach. Immutable off-site backups in Vault gave the company confidence that clean recovery points would always be available and direct migration from its previous cloud provider eliminated any disruption to daily operations. Capabilities like Instant Recovery reduced the time it took to bring critical systems back online, saving the IT team hundreds of hours each year. With Veeam ONE, Lamps Plus gained better visibility and control through proactive alerts and capacity planning, and Virtual Labs created a safe space for staff to test patches and upgrades before deploying them into production.

The impact was immediate. Lamps Plus now protects 99% of its IT environment, a big leap from the 30% coverage it had before. Recovery processes that once posed financial risk are now measured in minutes, with virtual machines (VMs) restored on-premises or in the cloud with ease. Vault has also lowered storage costs, offering transparent, per-terabyte pricing without unexpected egress or API fees. Day-to-day operations have become simpler as well, since any member of the IT team — even entry-level helpdesk staff — can restore files and systems quickly.

GORI mitigates ransomware risk and strengthens compliance with Veeam Vault

GORI provides drinking water and wastewater services to more than a million people in Italy's Campania region. Its responsibility extends across 5,200 kilometers of water networks, 13 purification facilities, and 200 treatment sites. Behind this physical infrastructure is a digital backbone that controls water treatment, supports laboratory testing, and delivers data to field engineers. Any disruption has the potential to impact essential services, which makes data resilience both a technical and public responsibility.

As a designated operator of critical national infrastructure, GORI must comply with stringent regulations while defending itself from the growing risk of ransomware. The company already had a disciplined backup approach in place, but leaders knew it was time to strengthen their defenses further. They identified three priorities: Creating immutable, off-site copies of mission-critical data, ensuring rapid recovery in the event of an attack, and reducing operational risk by simplifying management.

GORI selected Veeam Data Platform with Vault to meet these goals too. The IT team configured Veeam to back up both on-premises systems and Microsoft 365 applications, then directed secondary copies to Vault for immutable, logically air-gapped protection. This alignment with the 3-2-1-1-0 rule gave the organization greater confidence in its ability to recover clean data, no matter the scenario. Vault's high-performance storage tier enabled fast restoration, from entire systems down to individual files. GORI also benefited from direct engagement with Veeam experts, who supported configuration, training, and a smooth rollout across the environment.

The results are clear. With immutable backups secured in Vault, GORI has stronger protection against ransomware and a streamlined path to regulatory compliance. Recovery times have been shortened dramatically, with Microsoft 365 applications and on-premises systems restored in minutes. Day-to-day management has also become more efficient, giving IT teams more time to focus on the company's critical mission of keeping water clean and accessible.

FAAC Technologies unifies global data protection and cuts storage costs by 40% with Veeam Vault

FAAC Technologies is one of the world's leaders in automated entry solutions, serving residential, commercial, and industrial clients through 53 companies on five continents. Growth through acquisition has expanded its reach but also created a fragmented IT landscape. Each acquired business brought its own backup tools, leaving the global organization with inconsistent protection policies, rising costs, and increased exposure to ransomware.

The IT team recognized that a unified approach was essential. Data volumes were climbing each year, driving up storage costs and complicating management. At the same time, inconsistent practices across subsidiaries made it harder to ensure resilience and compliance. The goal was clear: Establish a single global standard for data protection that could reduce risk and simplify operations, while keeping expenses under control.

To achieve this, FAAC standardized Veeam Data Platform for onpremises systems and Veeam Backup for Microsoft 365 for cloud workloads. The company then extended protection with Veeam Vault, giving it immutable, encrypted, and logically air-gapped storage for long-term retention. Migration support from Veeam experts ensured smooth onboarding, both for on-premises systems and Microsoft 365 data moved into Veeam Data Cloud. With this combination, FAAC was able to consolidate multiple tools into one global solution, align backup policies across its business units, and take advantage of predictable cloud economics. The shift delivered immediate results. FAAC reduced on-premises storage and maintenance costs by up to 40%, freeing budget and resources for other priorities. Data protection is now consistent across the global organization, strengthening its resilience against ransomware and compliance risk. Recovery is faster and more reliable, whether restoring an individual mailbox or bringing entire systems back online.

The Premier Bank PLC cuts recovery time by 65% and reduces backup management by 75% with Veeam Vault

The Premier Bank PLC is one of Bangladesh's leading financial institutions, serving more than four million customers through 200 branches and a fast-growing digital channel. Its operations depend on a complex IT environment of over 1,000 virtual and bare-metal servers. Ensuring always-on availability is critical, both for customer trust and regulatory compliance.

The bank's existing approach could not keep pace with demand. A patchwork of manual tools covered only a fraction of systems, leaving large portions of the environment unprotected. Managing backups required four full-time staff, yet recovery remained slow and incomplete. At the same time, ransomware attacks were increasing across the banking sector, putting customer data and core services at risk. Leaders saw the need for a centralized strategy that could deliver stronger cyber resilience, reduce management overhead, and support rapid recovery.

The bank deployed Veeam Data Platform to unify protection across its environment and added Veeam Vault for immutable, encrypted, logically air-gapped cloud storage. Core banking databases were secured first, followed by the entire server estate. Veeam's automation and alerting eliminated much of the manual oversight once required, while built-in compression reduced storage needs by up to 65%. Vault provided immutable backup copies with transparent, per-terabyte pricing that included reads, writes, and egress, giving the bank clarity and control over costs.

The benefits have been significant. Backup management efforts have been cut by 75%, reducing the requirement from four staff to just one. Recovery times are now up to 65% faster, with critical systems restored in as little as 30 minutes. Immutable backups stored in Vault give the bank confidence that clean recovery points will always be available, ensuring resilience in the face of ransomware. Transparent pricing has also made it easier to forecast and control IT costs.
